

Judging

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| Morning judging | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each team will be scheduled for three morning interviews – one for each of the three judging areas and each with a pair of judges. • The judges will be asking questions consistent with the relevant rubric. • Only team members may interact with the judges. • Any others who interact will be asked to leave the room. |
| Robot Design 10-minute Interview | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plan to present your Robot Design Executive Summary in 4 minutes or less. • Bring your robot and any attachments • Be prepared to answer questions about your team’s robot design and programming • Discussion with judges will last ~6 minutes • There may be observers who watch your interaction with the judges |
| Project 10-minute Interview | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bring any equipment you need for your presentation • Each team has 5 minutes to set up AND present its research, with no adult help • Discussion with judges will last ~5 minutes • There may be observers who watch your presentation |
| Core Values 10-minute Interview | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be prepared to show off your team spirit during a special core values challenge lasting ~5 minutes • You will have 2 minutes to present your Core Values Poster. • Discussion with judges will last ~3 minutes • No observers (except for coaches) will be allowed in the room. |
| Call Backs | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the judges decide they need more information from a team, they may schedule an afternoon “call back” session. • Coaches will be notified of call-back appointments early afternoon. |
| Rubrics | Completed rubrics will be available for pick-up at the end of the day. |
