



The Pit



The Pit	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• “The Pit” is the space where teams gather during the competition.• Each team is assigned a space (approximately 10’ by 10’), containing a table and seating.• Pit space is limited. Please be considerate.• Each table will have a sign showing pit number, team number, and team name. The sign <u>must</u> be visible throughout the day.• Pit maps will be posted.• Each team is encouraged to decorate its assigned space – banners, balloons, etc. Freestanding displays are welcome. Any tape used must be “blue painter’s tape.” No other tape, please.
Behavior	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Teams should plan to be in the official competition areas at all times, except during lunch.• If a Jr.FLL Expo is available, visits are encouraged.• Pit Managers have the authority to manage pit congestion, pit conduct, and pit safety.
Power	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Power will be available at shared charging stations.• The charging stations should be used as needed to charge laptops and/or robot batteries.• The charging stations are not work areas.• Please be considerate of other teams.
Spectators	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spectators are permitted to visit the pits to see the teams’ displays and talk to team members, but should plan to sit in the spectator area.
Practice tables	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• There will be several robot game practice tables for use by teams.• Plan to use the shared practice tables.• Usage of the practice tables will be will monitored by Practice Table Managers.• Sign up with a Practice Table Manager for a time slot.• Please be considerate and respectful of other teams.
Challenge sets	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Unless your team is loaning your Challenge Set (mat & models) for use during the competition, do not bring your team’s set. Space is limited.
